SECTION A

1. Explain fully what the Buddha had achieved in His 45 years of Ministry. How did His efforts pave the way for the spreading of the Dhamma after His Mahaparinibbana until the present day?
2. The Buddha was known as the Omniscient One. What are the Nine Virtues of the Buddha? Please explain clearly on each virtue and tell us why He is known as the Omniscient One in this Universe with illustration from the Jakata story.
3. The Buddha was known as “Amatassa Data” (Giver of Deathlessness). Please explain clearly the Nine Virtues of the Buddha, then elaborate why He is known as “Giver of Deathlessness” with the support from the Jakata story.

SECTION B

4. In Sigalovada Sutta, there are six directions: North, South, East, West, Nadir and Zenith. In the East direction is the son’s duties towards his parents. What are these duties mentioned in this Sutta? Please explain fully with illustration from the Jataka story.
5. What are the Ten Fetters (Dasa Samyojana)? Explain clearly how one may eradicate these fetters with the practice of Sila, Samadhi & Pa ñña to lead us to attain Arahantship.
6. What is the Law of Dependent Origination (Paticca Samuppada)? Explain clearly how the Dependent Origination helps us to get an answer from where we are searching for the truth to end the suffering of birth, old age, sickness and death.

SECTION C

7. State clearly the principle event in the life of Arahant Sivali. What parami had he cultivated in his past life? Illustrate your answer from a Jataka story.
8. What are the nine virtues of the Sangha? Explain clearly each one of the nine virtues of the Sangha and give a Jataka story from the life of the Sangha, any one incident to show the one virtue of the Sangha.
9. Describe clearly how the Ven. Sariputta Thero came to realize and accept the Buddha’s teaching as uttered in the verses by Ven. Assaji Thero and elaborate some major incident to show that he was a son of filial piety to repay his parents’ debt before he attained Nibbana. Explain.
