- 4. Explain how the Five Laws of Nature (Pancaniyama) govern sentient beings besides the Law of Kamma.
- 5. What is the Law of Dependent Origination? Explain clearly how it leads beings from birth to death.
- 6. What are the three characteristics (Tilakkhana)? Explain clearly how by practicing the Dhamma it will make us understand the three characteristics of life.

### (PART C)

- 7. Trace the events that lead to the establishment of the Bhikkhuni Sangha. What significance does the Order of Nuns had on the status of women in India at that time?
- 8. Explain clearly Venerable Ananda's duties and contributions as the attendant monk until the Buddha's Parinibbana.
- 9. What are the qualities and virtues of Venerable Maha Kassapa? Illustrate an incident that qualifies him to lead the First Buddhist Council.

## (PART D)

- 10. What are the conditions for breaking the fourth precept (Musavada)? Explain why it is difficult to uphold this precept purely without breaking it?
- 11. What are the 11 benefits of practicing metta? Explain how to cultivate metta in daily life.
- 12. What are the teachings of the Buddha on filial piety? Explain fully from the extracts of Suttas and give illustrations from the Jatakas.
